Co-location of the BioEscalator with leading Oxford medical researchers and hospitals is central to its vision. Oxford's Old Road Campus is home to many of the University's world-class institutes and departments, as well as the Churchill Hospital. The Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre is over the road and the John Radcliffe Hospital is a short walk away. The Old Road Campus is linked to the University science area 2 miles away by a regular minibus, the Science Transit Shuttle.
